## Activity Corner



### Ingredients needed:

- 1 tsp. Borax
- 2 bottles white glue
- 1 cup warm water
- Neon orange food coloring

### Directions:

1. Pour two bottles of white glue into large bowl.
2. Fill the glue bottles with warm water and shake them.
3. Pour that water into the bowl along with the glue.
4. Add neon orange food coloring (plain orange is fine too.)
5. Dissolve 1 teaspoon of Borax into  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of warm water.
6. Pour into the glue and food coloring mixture and stir until the Gak comes together.
